I. Policy:

- A. All JPA member agencies shall comply with the California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Section 3202, "Illness and Injury Prevention Program".
- B. All JPA provider agencies shall have a written illness and injury program that, at a minimum, addresses the following elements:
 - 1. Responsibility for illness and injury prevention
 - 2. Communication
 - 3. Accident/Exposure investigation
 - 4. Training and education
 - 5. Compliance
 - 6. Hazard assessment
 - 7. Hazard correction
 - 8. Record-keeping
- C. All JPA provider agencies shall participate in the county-wide Critical Incident Stress.
- D. The JPA may request copies of a provider agency's Illness and Injury Prevention Program for compliance review.

II. Purpose:

To establish a standard for the protection of and the prevention of illness and injury for all JPA members.
