Policy Subject Matter: Utilization of Air Ambulance

I. Policy:

A. Immediate transportation via air ambulance should be considered in the presence of one or more of the following criteria:

- 1. Critical time factors
- 2. Need for advanced procedures
- 3. Base hospital recommendation
- 4. Mechanism of injury
- 5. Trauma patient with significant sign/symptoms (i.e., altered mental status; spinal cord injury with neurologic deficit; open head, neck or chest injury; significant blunt neck, chest, or abdominal injury; burns over 18% TBSA).
- 6. Remote geographic location or difficult topography.
- 7. Other factors which, in the judgment of the Incident Commander, warrant air transportation.
- B. The ECC shall dispatch an air ambulance upon request of the Incident Commander or the highest medical personnel in route or present on scene.
- C. Air transportation shall be dispatched in conformance with internal ECC policies and procedures and EMS Agency guidelines.

II. Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the appropriate and prompt dispatch of air ambulance transportation to the scene of an emergency.
